# **TRAFFIC COMMITTEE MINUTES – Thursday, April 20, 2023**

TIME: 5:30 P.M.

LOCATION: Executive Conference Room

- Call to Order/Introductions The meeting was called to order at 5:30 P.M.
- **Approve minutes of February 16, 2023 Regular Meeting** Motion was made by Committee Member Jamil, seconded by Committee Member Zambon, to approve the minutes as presented. The Committee voted unanimously to approve the motion.
- Matters from the Audience None.
- **Traffic Collision and Citations Report** Members discussed the monthly and annual trends of collisions and citations. The report was received and filed.
- **Applied Composites Parking Request** The City Traffic Engineer summarized Applied Composites' parking request for on-street parking off of Columbia St. He proposed to add three "No Parking" signs, between the hours of 6:00pm-6:00am, on the north side of Columbia St. The representative for Applied Composites added that they are currently renting parking spots from neighboring businesses, and have the need for additional parking based on their training of staff. The proposed parking signs would add roughly 20 additional parking spots for their business, and would be considered a temporary request. A motion was made and approved to concur with the temporary signage.
- Imperial Highway & Jasmine Drive Traffic Signal The City Traffic Engineer summarized the previous discussion from the February 16<sup>th</sup> Traffic Committee meeting, where the City Staff gave a presentation on the Arovista Park Modernization Project. He discussed the findings of the data that was collected for the intersection of Jasmine Dr. and Imperial Hwy.

The City Traffic Engineer also shared the following feedback regarding the intersection timing from Caltrans:

- Caltrans will work with the City to adjust signal timing as necessary as a result of the changing driveway conditions.
- Caltrans will not make any changes to the signal timing prior to completion of the park improvements.
- The current minimum green signal timing allocated to northbound Jasmine Dr. traffic is 10 seconds (roughly 4 cars). The current maximum green signal timing allocated to northbound Jasmine Dr. traffic is 17 seconds (roughly 6 cars).
- The cycle length for the AM and PM peak times is 130 seconds.

A motion was made to approve, provided the accuracy of the date presented, that traffic at the intersection has been studied, that the one-way exit driveway configuration has been reviewed, and is acceptable with the proposed park, and that the City Staff is to coordinate with Caltrans on any improvements needed once the park has been implemented.

- **Project Updates** City Traffic Engineer and staff reported on the following items:
  - Falcon Elementary School The City Traffic Engineer confirmed that the neighborhood has been notified of the improvements. The signage has been installed, and the red curbs will be installed the following week.
  - Lambert Rd. & Brea Blvd. The City Staff attained permit from MWD. Econolite is scheduling work and coordinating with MWD.

### Committee Member Comments –

- <u>Chair Hickenbottom –</u> Requested the inspection of the left-turn signal westbound down Birch St. to Kraemer Blvd.
- <u>Vice Chair Jamil</u> Requested the Public Works Superintendent follow up on the no-truck signage along Santa Fe Rd and Valencia Ave.
- <u>Committee Member Zambon –</u> Requested to have the Public Works Superintendent verify that the push buttons and in-pavement flashing beacons are functioning along Birch St. in Brea Downtown.
- Adjourn The meeting was adjourned @ 6:50 pm. Next scheduled meeting is May 18, 2023.
